**Motion by Nancy Bader to add the following two agenda items to Section 14 – Other: vacation carryover request and notice of action regarding the ordinance for fees due for motor vehicle tax delinquency. The motion was seconded by Bill Black and carried by a unanimous vote.**

**Motion by Bill Black to accept the minutes of the April 27, 2004 meeting with the following changes: page 2, the date in the last sentence in item 1 should read May 4, 2004 and not May 7, 2004; page 5, item 10.a, the dimensions of the building should be 32 feet by 32 feet and not 20 feet by 30 feet; item 10.a., same paragraph, the word “liability” should be replaced with “responsibility” and page 7, re the motion regarding the CDAC, delete the words “the motion was seconded by Sharon Reiner...” and replace with “the motion was seconded by Bill Black ...” The motion was seconded by Sharon Reiner and it was carried by a unanimous vote.**

**Motion by Sharon Reiner to appoint Walter Jones as an alternate to the Zoning Commission. The motion was seconded by Bill Black and it was carried by a unanimous vote.**

**Motion by Bill Black to authorize Nancy Bader to subordinate a loan under the housing rehabilitation program with respect to a house on Hickory Rd. to Argent Mortgage Company. The motion was seconded by Sharon Reiner and it was carried by a unanimous vote.**

**Motion by Sharon Reiner to approve the vacation carryover request of Gerry Black as per her memo dated May 3, 2004. The motion was seconded by Nancy Bader. Bill Black abstained. Motion passed.**

**Motion by Sharon Reiner to waive the reading of the entire ordinance re fees due for motor vehicle tax delinquency. The motion was seconded by Bill Black and it was carried by a unanimous vote.**

**Motion by Bill Black to adopt the ordinance re fees due for motor vehicle tax delinquency. The motion was seconded by Sharon Reiner and it was carried by a unanimous vote.**
