Meetings

Business meetings are held the fourth Monday of every month at 9:30am at the Marlborough Congregational Church.

In addition to business meetings, we also have outings or other get-togethers, such as playgroups, park days, field trips to local museums, discussion groups and family parties.

Activity Groups

The MOMS Club® sponsors activity groups for members with common interests. These change as interests change, but may include activities such as lunch groups, arts 'n' crafts, recipe club, book club, knitting circle, a monthly MOMS Night Out and babysitting co-ops.

We also plan community service projects two or three times a year. Some of our previous projects have been collecting food for a local food pantry, and sponsoring a local family to provide holiday gifts of clothing to the children.

Dues

Our dues are \$25 per year and pay for operating expenses such as copies and postage, program sponsorships, and \$2 per member is sent to MOMS Club International's Mother-to-Mother Fund to help MOMS Club® mothers suffering from natural disasters and devastating situations.

Bring Your Children!

We believe being a mother shouldn't isolate you, so you may bring your children with you to anything we do (except MOMS Night Out). You don't have to bring your children to attend, but if you do, please remember you are responsible for your child's safety and behavior.
