RE: Bull Hill Road Culvert Replacement & Paving Projects

Starting on Thursday, June 22nd, the Town will begin repairs and improvements to the Marlborough section of Bull Hill Road. The initial phase of the work will include replacing seven (7) cross-culverts located on Bull Hill Road. The work will require Bull Hill Road to be closed to all through traffic from the Ogden Lord Road intersection to the South Road intersection during construction hours from 7:30am to 3:00pm for a period of 3 to 4 weeks, depending on weather conditions. We realize this will be an inconvenience, but there is no reasonable alternative. We are hoping to minimize the impact to residents and to complete the project as quickly as possible.

The Board of Selectman will be holding a Project Public Information Meeting on Tuesday, June 6th at 6:00 pm in the Town Hall Conference Room located at 26 North Main Street, to review the plans and answer your questions. The project plans will be posted on the Town Website for your review and are also available in the Land Use/Building Department in Town Hall during Town Hall hours (Monday, Wednesday & Thursday 8:00am to 4:30pm, Tuesday 8:00am to 7:00pm, & Friday 8:00 am to 12:00pm)
