

## 2018 Election Deadlines

The Registrar of Voters normal business hours are Tuesday from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Voters may also register in the Town Clerk's office any day during regular office hours.

Absentee Ballot Applications for the November 2018 Election are available at the Town Clerk's Office (860) 295-6206.

Stated below are voter registration deadlines and special voter registration hours for the November 6, 2018 Election.

- **Mail-In Registration** must be postmarked by 10/30/2018.
- **Registration made through the CT Secretary of State's website** <https://voterregistration.ct.gov/OLVR/welcome.do> must be completed by midnight 10/30/2018.
- **Registration made through the DMV and AAA offices** must be completed by midnight 10/30/2018.
- **In Person** until Tuesday, 10/30/2018 at 8:00 p.m.
- The Registrar of Voters office will hold special voter registration sessions on:
  - Tuesday, October 30th from 8:30 to 8 p.m.
  - Any person 18 years of age, is naturalized as a citizen or a Marlborough resident after October 30, 2018 may register to vote in person no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 5, 2018. The Registrar's office will be open from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for this purpose. For the hours of 12:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m., the Town Clerk's office will be open to receiving voter registration cards. Proof of age, citizenship or new residence in Marlborough must be submitted.
  - **Election Day Registration will be held on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 in the Large Conference Room, Marlborough Town Hall from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. allowing eligible individuals (residing in Marlborough) to register to vote and cast a ballot on Election Day. Proof of residence in Marlborough is required.**

The Election Day Registration requires that in order to cast a ballot on Election Day, the applicant must be registered to vote no later than 8:00 p.m. **Applicants, who continue to be in line after 8:00 p.m., will not be able to participate in the election. All applicants must have completed the EDR process before 8:00 p.m. in order to cast a ballot on Election Day.**
