Re: Lake Terramuggus Common Reed and Cattail Control Program

Dear Ms. Taversa:

As you are aware, SOLitude Lake Management was contracted by the Town of Marlborough to implement an upland plant management program at Lake Terramuggus. This management program is focused on the shoreline area to selectively control nuisance Cattail (typha) and Common Reed (phragmites australis) growth. Given nature of the management areas, the selective systemic USEPA/CT registered aquatic herbicide Glyphosate (tradename Aqua-Pro) was selected for use.

Glyphosate is a USEPA/CT registered aquatic herbicide that when used in accordance with the product label by licensed pesticide applicators poses little risk to the environment and human health. According to the EPA product label, there is no water use restrictions with the use of Glyphosate. However, we will ask that people stay out of the treated areas for 12 hours as an extra precaution.

Treatment of the emergent plants is scheduled for September 26th with a back- up rain date of the 27th. SOLitude will post signs around all the areas that will be treated. If there are any questions please feel to reach out to the office. (508-865-1000)
