

## PRESS RELEASE

The Town of Marlborough is pleased to announce that the long-awaited South Main Street Pavement Rehabilitation Project will begin on September 25th! The project includes milling the road surface, making drainage improvements, replacing a bridge deck, and then repaving the road surface from 9 South Main Street (the Barber Shop) to the "V" intersection of South Road with South Main Street. The work is being performed by TradeMark Contractors, LLC of Bristol, CT, and is expected to be completed by spring 2018.

During the last fiscal year, the Town of Marlborough paid approximately \$87,628 for the engineering and design of this project. Now, 100% of the remaining \$1,097,615 construction cost of this project is being funded through the Local Transportation Capital Improvement Program (known as LOTCIP), which provides State funds to area municipal governments.

As with any construction/rehabilitation project, residents should expect some inconvenience and delay. To improve safety for both residents and workers, and to help alleviate delays, an alternating traffic signal will be put in place at the stream crossing abutting the DOT Garage for the duration of the project. Any resident who has questions or who would like additional information is welcome to attend a pre-construction Open Forum on Tuesday, September 19th at 6:30pm at Town Hall. Staff will also be available to address any questions or concerns during construction.
