

Today, the General Assembly passed and Governor Lamont is expected to sign, HB 5765 which (1) establishes a loan program for certain federal employees impacted by the federal government shutdown, (2) allows towns and cities to establish a tax-deferment program for those federal employees' real and personal property or motor vehicle taxes, and (3) allows those federal employees' to receive unemployment compensation benefits.

The Federal Government Shutdown is now the longest in United States history, and these provisions will only last the duration of the shutdown. If you are a Federal employee and need assistance, please contact the First Selectman at (860)295-6204.
